- Book return bins at Millennium Rec Centre, Ardrossan Rec Centre & Bethel Transit Centre

Overdue?

Here's the scoop.

Please make sure you return borrowed materials on or before the due date. You'll save yourself the late fees, which are applied daily on each overdue item.

See website or Check Out Desk for detailed information on fees and charges.

Need a little more time?

Here's how to renew.

Library materials may be renewed up to two times if:

- They are not requested by another borrower
- Your library card is current
- You have fewer than 40 overdue items
- You have less than \$15 in overdue fines

Extended loans may be arranged for special circumstances like vacations.

Bestseller Express, magazines and items with a hold placed on them cannot be renewed.

Renewing is easy.

Online - Log in at www.sclibrary.ca and renew your materials in "Checked Out" under "My SCL"

By phone - Call VELMA, our renewal line at 780.417.2171 or call the Check Out Desk at 780.410.8600.

In person - At the Check Out Desk, or on the Bookmobile.

Looking for something that's checked out?

Place a hold.

Log in at www.sclibrary.ca, search for your item and click "Place a Hold". You'll be notified by email or phone – your choice – when the item is ready to be picked up. You have until one week after the notification to pick up.

Manage your card online.

"My SCL" at www.sclibrary.ca makes it easy to manage your account online. See what you have out, when it's due, place and check on holds, renew materials, and more.

Signing in is simple. Enter your card number, username and your PIN. Your PIN is provided when you register, but you can change it any time.
